I have already contacted Linda Irvine of the **Reunion B.R.A.T.** about accommodations and several planned events.

We are currently planning the installation of a commemorative plaque to be placed at the base of the flagpole at Site 4 at the invitation of Gary Baker. Gary attended our previous Roswell reunion in 2000 and has since completed the renovations of the LCC, the cap and portions of the Silo access tunnel. The site is now used as an on-line data storage facility for companies in need of a secure 'hard-site'. The renovation/restoration is impressive. (Note: I was a Q.C. inspector to this site in June/September, 1962, while I was assigned to A.F. Quality Control)



We are also planning the installation of a similar plaque to be placed in the Unit Display area of the Air Terminal located at the Roswell Industrial Air Center (formerly Walker Air Force Base). I have been in contact with the Mayor of Roswell and the Manager of the Air Terminal, and they have indicated that our plaque will be placed along side the current display area. The tentative plaque display is shown below.



The plaque will be created and cast by Terry Karselis (former 579th member) who is now a renowned sculptor. My thanks to Terry for his assistance on the design.
